



Industry Briefing on SeaVax 2.0 – 5 November 2021



What enhancements approved :

The enhanced phase now provides vaccination to the following:

- Crew onboard Vessels at Anchorage
- Crew onboard Vessels at PSA and JP terminals (container and multi-purpose port terminals)
- Crew onboard Vessels that are in Shipyards
- Including Sign-On crew arriving from the Airport joining vessels

What enhancements approved :

Crew will be able to get the following:

- 1st dose
- 2nd dose (if they meet the WHO guidelines on interval period from 1st dose)
- MOH recommends that 2nd dose can be taken under 90 days from the 1st dose
- 3rd booster dose (as long as they meet the WHO guidelines of at least six (6) months from the 2nd dose)

Requirements

Only Crew who wished to be vaccinated to undergo supervised self-swab ART

All other restrictions are lifted i.e. there's no restrictions on last port of call etc, 2nd dose / mix dose (see FAQ document for J&J/Sinovac and other non-WHO EUL vaccines)

All pathways to vaccination open : All sign-on Crew and Crew from anchorages, JP and PSA terminals are eligible to apply for vaccination

SeaVax 2.0: Eligibility Requirements

Only AG- crew will be allowed to disembark for vaccination

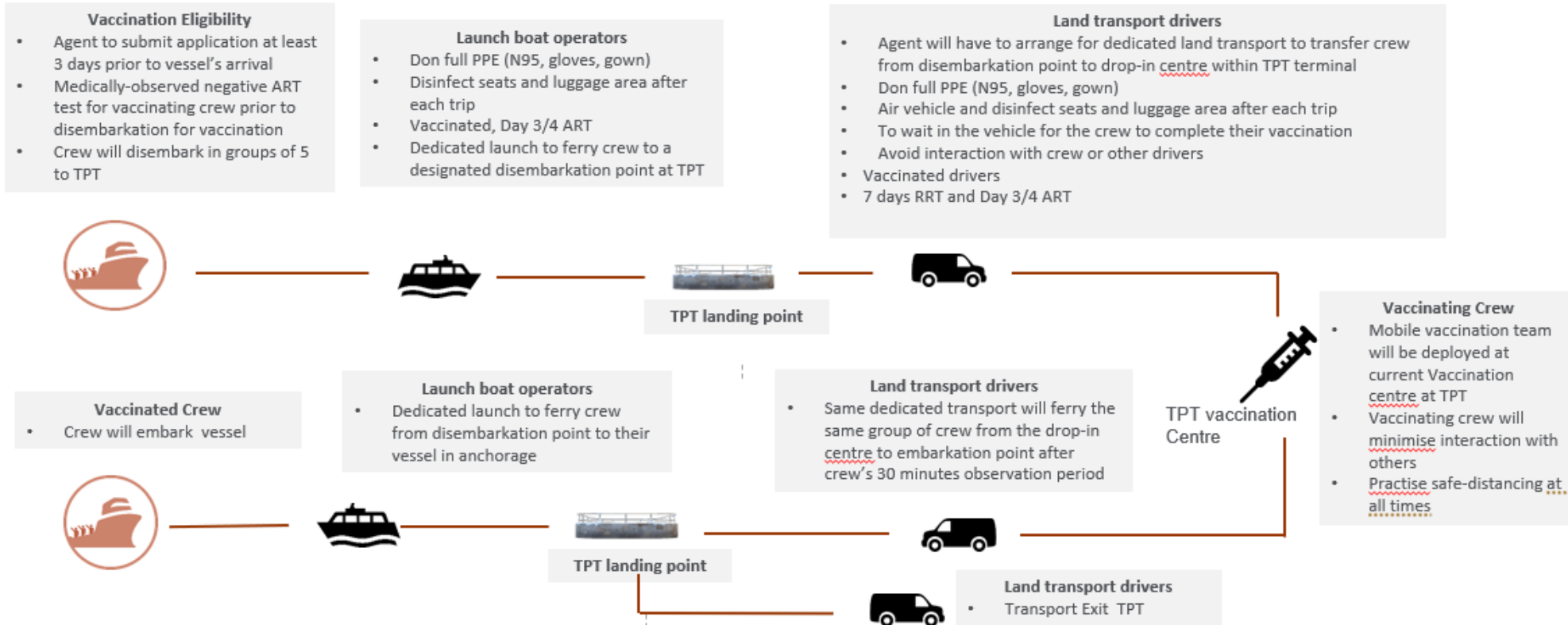
Crew who are AG+ will isolate him/herself onboard as per MOH 1-2-3 protocol

AG test results will not be recorded anywhere – the purpose of the AG test is to ensure that the crew coming down shore is clean

Medical Service Provider (MSP) will issue a memo once crew AG test are cleared

Crew will take a dedicated bus/launch to Tg Pagar Terminal (TPT)

Ocean-Going Vaccination Protocol – (for crew onboard vessels at anchorages) **No ICA clearance required**



Ocean-Going Vaccination Protocol – (for crew at PSA/JP Terminals)

[same process for crew coming from shipyard]

Vaccination Eligibility

- Agent to submit application at least 3 days prior to vessel's arrival
- Medically-observed negative ART test for vaccinating crew prior to disembarkation for vaccination
- Crew will disembark in groups of 5 to a dedicated drop-in vaccination centre

Onboard Crew

- Transport to meet Crew at Vessel berth
- Vaccinating Crew in groups of 5 per transport
- Crew to go direct to TPT

Vaccinating Crew

- Mobile vaccination team will be deployed at dedicated drop-in centre at the terminals
- Vaccinating crew will minimise interaction with others
- Practise safe-distancing at all times

Vaccinated Crew

- Crew will board Transport vessel right after the 30-minute observation period



Terminal



Land transport drivers

- Don full PPE (N95, gloves, gown)
- Air vehicle and disinfect seats and luggage area after each trip
- To wait in the vehicle for the crew to complete their vaccination
- Avoid interaction with crew or other drivers
- Vaccinated drivers
- 7 days RRT and Day 3/4 ART



TPT Vaccination Centre



Transport

- Transport will wait at TPT Vaccination Center for crew, while crew complete vaccination



Vaccinated Crew

- Transport to send crew back to PPT
- Crew boards Vessel



Transport Leaves PPT

- After dropping Crew to board vessel at berth, Transport exits PPT



Terminal

Ocean-Going Vaccination Protocol – (for sign-on crew going onboard vessel on the same day) **No ART needed**

Vaccination Eligibility

- Negative ART test prior to departure to Singapore
- Undertaking by company and Seafarer (Seafarer Employment Agreement document)
- P&I Club Insurance Cover

Land transport drivers

- Don full PPE (N95, gloves, gown)
- Air vehicle and disinfect seats and luggage area after each trip
- To wait in the vehicle for the crew to complete their vaccination
- Avoid interaction with crew or other drivers
- Vaccinated drivers
- Day 3/4 ART

Holding areas at MSP/WCP

- Crew to be transported to MSP/WCP Designated holding areas for sign-on/off crew to prevent mixing with general public

Meet-and-greet staff

- Don mask, face shield, and gloves

TPT Vaccination Centre

Vaccinating Crew

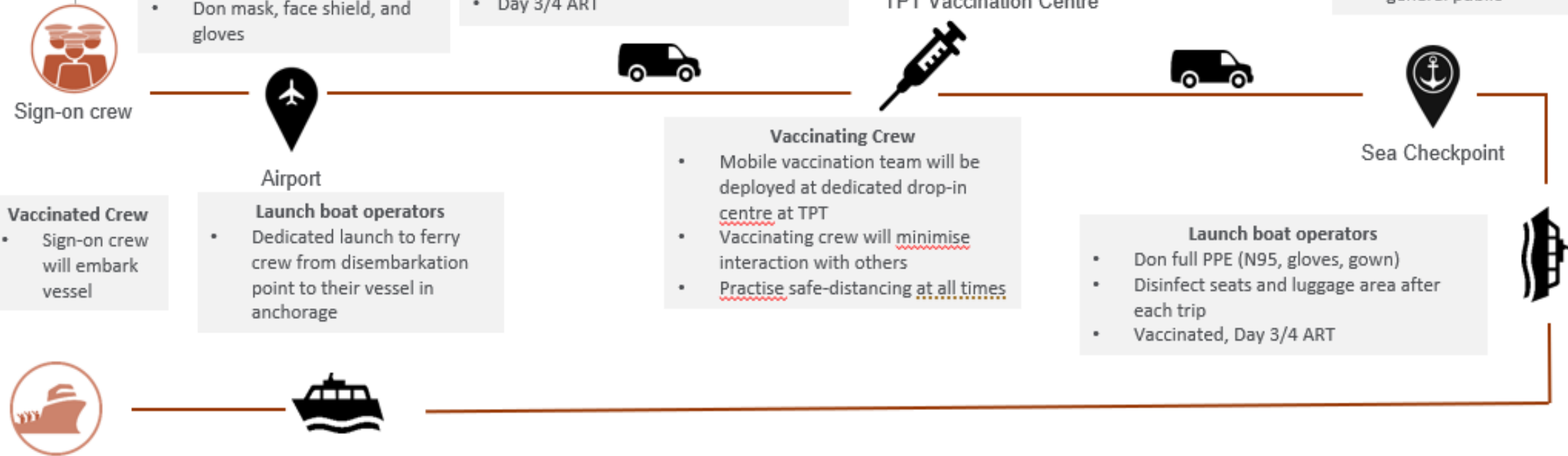
- Mobile vaccination team will be deployed at dedicated drop-in centre at TPT
- Vaccinating crew will minimise interaction with others
- Practise safe-distancing at all times

Launch boat operators

- Don full PPE (N95, gloves, gown)
- Disinfect seats and luggage area after each trip
- Vaccinated, Day 3/4 ART

Launch boat operators

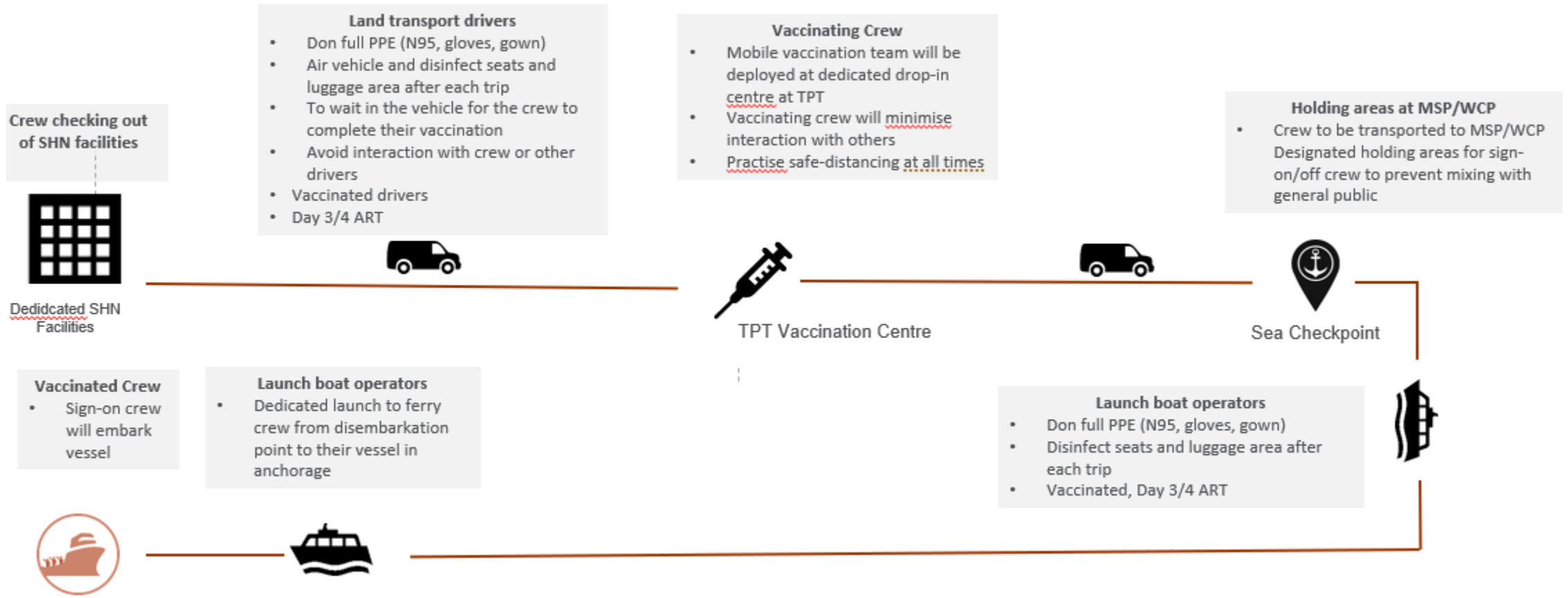
- Dedicated launch to ferry crew from disembarkation point to their vessel in anchorage



Vaccinated Crew

- Sign-on crew will embark vessel

Ocean-Going Vaccination Protocol – (for crew from Crewsafe facility in SG) **No ART needed**



Timing : 3 days, 48hrs and 24hrs

- Prior application is **required 3 days** in advance at: <https://go.gov.sg/mpa-icc-seavax>
 - For ICA clearance of disembarking crew (from terminals & shipyards)
 - Rostering/Activation of Vaccination team,
 - Vaccine preparations
- Shipowners/Mgrs/Agents to inform of any changes within **48hrs**
- **24hrs** before the scheduled vaccination, following should be provided:
 - Vehicle and driver details (for port entry security clearance into Vax centre)
 - Proof of payment (e-banking)
 - Memo from Medical Svc Provider which states that crew are all AG-

COVID-19 Case Management

- In the event that there is a C+/AG+ crew onboard, **vessel will still be allowed to come into the port to conduct their operations as planned.**
- Operations will be **contactless** as per the existing Singapore Safe Measures Mgmt.
- Affected crew will have to be isolated onboard. Medical assistance will only be rendered to crew who are in need of immediate/emergency medical attention – **this is in line with the national quarantine and MEDIVAC protocols.**
