# Key Changes

# Sign-On Crew

- Fully vaccinated crew from “Active Vaccinated Lane” may sign on without serving SHN and/or taking VTL flights
- The crew must have a negative PCR test result 2 days prior departure to Singapore
- For vaccinated crew from Category I/II/III/IV countries/regions, crew may produce a negative, professionally administered ART result
- FTT is no longer required for fully vaccinated crew
- For non-vaccinated crew, FTT 24 hours prior to departure to Singapore is still required
- Crew who are fully vaccinated and recently recovered (i.e. within 90 days of their last infection) will be exempted from all testing and SHN requirements if they are able to provide appropriate documentary proof
- Non-fully vaccinated recently recovered crew will be exempted from pre-departure testing requirements but will still be subjected to prevailing SHN requirements
- Fully vaccinated crew may use the designated crew change holding facilities for up to 5 days; unvaccinated crew may stay up to 24 hours

# Sign-Off Crew

- The crew must have not gone ashore in the last 7 days before disembarking the ship
- No interaction with shore-based personnel at previous port in the last 7 days
- PDT, where needed, shall be carried out onboard
  - Prior approval from MPA is required before medical service provider goes up onboard for PDT for sign off crew only
  - NO requirement for PCR test from last port
- Fully vaccinated crew may use the designated crew change holding facilities for up to 5 days; unvaccinated crew may stay up to 24 hours
