<sup>§</sup> If the crew arrives at Hong Kong on or after the 14th day upon completion of a COVID-19 vaccination course\* and meets the early discharge criteria as published on Government’s COVID-19 thematic website, his compulsory quarantine period may be shortened to 7 days.

\* For both the Sinovac COVID-19 vaccine (CoronaVac vaccine) and Fosun Pharma/BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine (Comirnaty vaccine), completing the vaccination course involves receiving two doses in general, except for persons previously infected with COVID-19, who are to receive one dose of vaccine. For persons aged between 12 and 17 on the scheduled day of arrival at Hong Kong, they may be deemed to have completed the COVID-19 vaccination course on receiving one dose of the Comirnaty vaccine. For individuals who received COVID-19 vaccines in places outside of Hong Kong and have received the recommended dose(s) as stipulated in the “List of COVID-19 Vaccines Recognised for Specified Purposes” as published on the Government’s COVID-19 thematic website as well as relevant guidelines, they will also be regarded to have completed the vaccination course of the relevant COVID-19 vaccine, subject to the vaccine used being included on that list.

The 14th day after a person has completed a COVID-19 vaccination course is counted by taking the next day after the person received all of the recommended dose(s) of COVID-19 vaccine as the 1st day. For example, for a person who has not been infected with COVID-19 previously and received the last recommended dose of COVID-19 vaccine on 1 April 2022, the “1st day” would be 2 April 2022 and the “14th day” would be 15 April 2022.

For the purpose of determining the quarantine period mentioned in section 3(1) of the Regulation, the relevant person must provide documentary proof of vaccination showing the relevant person has received COVID-19 vaccine and the date on which the last dose was administered, in accordance with the relevant criteria as published on the Government’s COVID-19 thematic website.

@ Upon arrival at Hong Kong, you must pay attention to your health condition, take body temperature twice daily and report to your shipping company/agent. If you feel unwell, please call 2125 1133 (have stayed in Mainland, Macao or Taiwan) or 2125 1999 (have stayed in all overseas countries/territories). You are allowed to operate another trip and must wear a surgical mask during work.
